Inauguration













Construction process: Interlocking hinged legs .

Detail of flip-in lateral stabilizers for legs.










The finishing process: sanding and linseed oil - lots of both.




The triangle remodel complete: Door, Wall, Desk.













Labyrinthine Projection™ portrait of Mr & MRs Mo on printed circuit board.











Chipped parts cast in resin form.





Working through the proprietary interlock scheme which allows for the interconnection of different sized tiles.





Milling the precision channels in length of cast material before slicing the form horizontally.






Finished tile made from scrap bits showing translucent quality.














Exploring the representational qualities of the Re-Tile form and process.

Overhead "grid" incorporates magnetics for dynamic effect.






